Our procedures included examination, on a test basis, of evidence supporting the amounts and other disclosures in the financial report, and the evaluation of significant accounting estimates. These procedures have been undertaken to form an opinion as to whether in all material respects, the financial report is presented fairly in accordance with the requirements of the Associations Incorporation Act.

The audit opinion expressed in this report has been formed on the above basis.

Qualification

A portion of income by way of donations and fund raising could not be varified until entered into the accounting records. Accordingly, our audit in relation to donations and fund raising was limited to amounts recorded.

In our opinion, subject to the effects of the limitation discussed in the qualification paragraph, the financial report—presents fairly the balance sheet and profit and loss accounts of the Save Foundation of Australia (Inc) for the year ended 31 March 1999.
